After a year at Normandale, she felt as if she had more to offer, so she transferred to Minnesota State Mankato to get a four-year degree in finance.

After a year of being a Maverick, Blotske switched to the Construction Management major. "Numbers were interesting, but I wanted to be in a field where I saw what those numbers really meant, not just what they were on paper" she said. In her early years of being in the Construction Management program, Blotske had to work harder than most to succeed, as she was one a very few women in the field at the time. "My first career fair was very uncomfortable. I had people make comments about going to the bars later instead of asking me if I was looking for an internship. One person even went as far to write some unnecessary comments referring to me being a woman at the top of my resume".

Despite these challenges, Blotske went on to have an exceptional career. She landed an internship with Adolfson and Peterson while in school. After she graduated, she was brought on full time and worked with Adolfson and Peterson for thirteen years. After her time with Adolfson and Peterson, she spent time with RJM construction, and now works for Ryan Companies.

Blotske is now a Senior Project Manager at Ryan Companies. She is currently overseeing several staff and four superintendents on a one-hundred-million-dollar project for Upsher-Smith in the Cities.
