

National Diversity Scholarship

Geared toward construction and engineering students, JE Dunn’s National Diversity Scholarship supports our 3-pillar strategy for diversity and inclusion: workforce, workplace, and marketplace.

01 WHAT IS IT?

The National Diversity Scholarship is a \$5,000 scholarship paid over the course of two years. It includes up to two guaranteed internship opportunities and is awarded to 8 students nationally each year.

02 WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

To qualify for the National Diversity Scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Sophomore or higher
- Person of color
- Enrolled in a construction or engineering program & minimum of 3.0 GPA
- Maintain employment authorization without future sponsorship needs

03 HOW DO I APPLY

JE Dunn is accepting applications for the National Diversity Scholarship until October 15, 2021.
